

ART THERAPY SESSION

Weekly employment in the community centre. It is for adults now, but a children's group could be started. They express themselves through creativity, talking about the feelings and thoughts they experience throughout.

HANDICRAFTS CLUB

During the craft club, the children made bird feeders, which, once completed, were placed at designated sites around the country.

CRAFT ACTIVITIES

During the craft sessions, children can paint, draw and take part in different seasonal craft activities.

SENIOR CLUB

The senior club offers various activities for our guests from week to week. The activities include music, singing, gymnastics, and handicrafts. Examples include learning to embroider mâché or making rag dolls representing families, which will be sent to the men fighting on the Ukrainian front.
